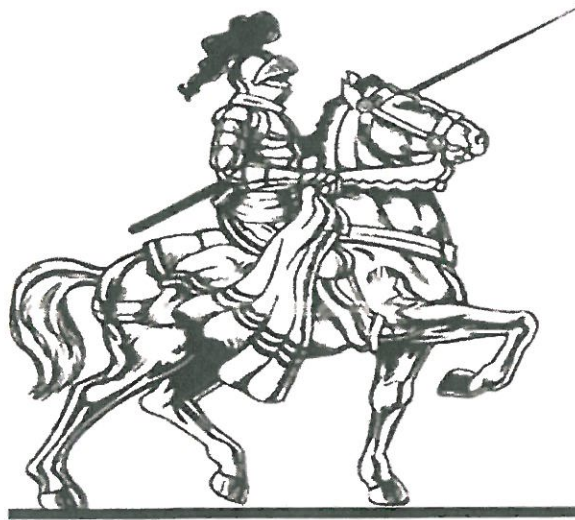

West Holmes Levy Timeline

The timeline is the current discussion and is subject to change based on legislation or district goals, updated 2011.

LEVIES

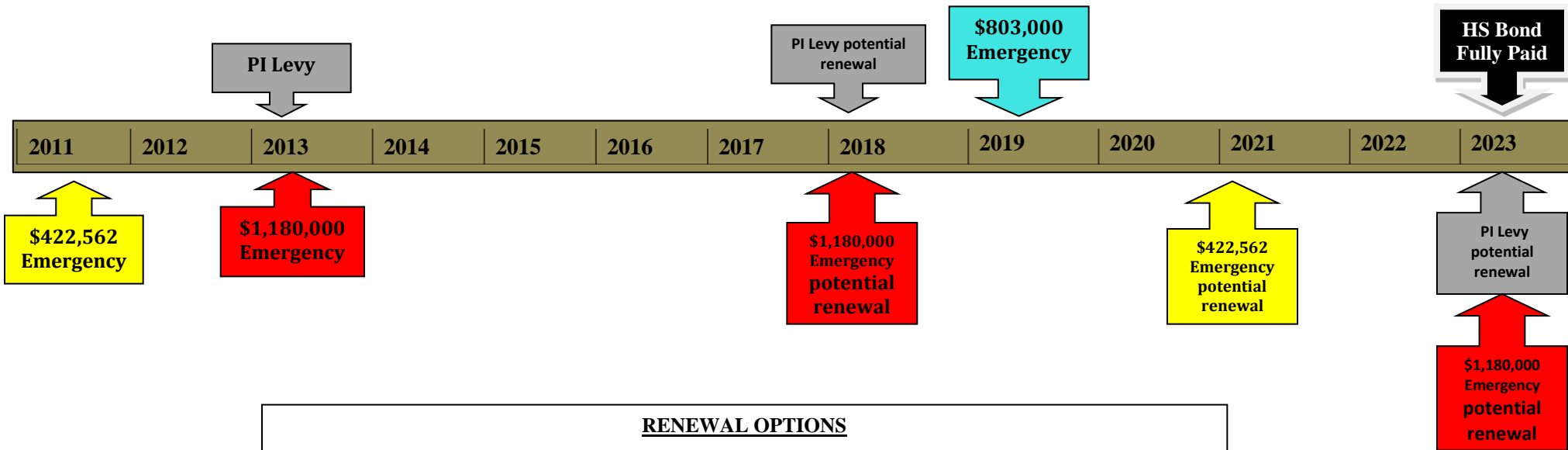
Permanent Improvement Levy – Originally passed in 1983 for 2.5 mills but currently collects at 1.18 mills (5 Yr)

Emergency Levy - \$422,562 – Originally passed and renewed since 1978. Currently 1.22 mills and renewal on in May 2011.

Emergency Levy - \$803,000 – Originally passed in 1994. (10 Yr passed in 2009)

Emergency Levy - \$1,180,000 – Originally passed in 2008. (5 Yr)

Bond Issue – No Renewals Needed – Expires 2023 – Originally 5.9 mills in 1996. Currently collects at 3.25 Mills.



RENEWAL OPTIONS

- Permanent Improvement levy term after 2008 renewal can be up to and including 5 years or continuing.
- Emergency renewal can be done as renewals up to and including 10 years, starting in 2009.
- Emergency levies can be done as substitute levies for a period up to and including 10 years or as a continuing. This allows for growth for new construction.
- Starting with levy in 2009 for \$803,000 levy, long-term planning as far as changing terms need to be done in order to reduce ballot burnout.



West Holmes **Renewal** Levy

Tuesday, May 3, 2011

Generates a fixed dollar amount of \$422,562 for 10 years at 1.22 mills.

Originally passed in 1978 and has been providing funds to the district for thirty-three (33) years.

Currently costs homeowner of a \$100,000 home, 10 cents per day

Levy provides the following to our children and grandchildren:

- Instructional, Maintenance, and Transportation Supplies
- Instructional and Support Personnel
- Utilities (Gas, Heat, Water, Sewer, Trash, etc.)
- Textbooks and Library Books
- State Mandated Testing and Scoring
- Printers, Overheads, and Maps

This levy will **not increase your property taxes.**
